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



Life Line Screenings Offered May 19

Life Line Screening, a leading provider of community-based preventive health screenings, will offer their affordable, non-invasive and painless health screenings at Surry County Senior Center.

Five screenings will be offered that scan for potential health problems related to: blocked arteries which is a leading cause of stroke; abdominal aortic aneurysms which can lead to a ruptured aorta; hardening of the arteries in the legs which is a strong predictor of heart disease; atrial fibrillation or irregular heart beat which is closely tied to stroke risk; and a bone density screening, for men and women, used to assess the risk of osteoporosis.

Register for a Wellness Package which includes 4 vascular tests and osteoporosis screening from \$149 (\$139 with our member discount). All five screenings take 60-90 minutes to complete.

The Seniors' Health Insurance Information Program (SHIIP) is available to help you work through your Medicare

options. If you have any questions or concerns call SHIIP at 1-855-408-1212. One-on-One Insurance Counseling is available at the Surry Senior Center through SHIIP upon request. The Senior Center can assist in making these appointments. (Appointments subject to the availability of a certified SHIIP Counselor.) Prescription Drugs: Medicare beneficiaries may be eligible for the federal Extra Help/Low Income Subsidy program if he/she has limited income and resources. Seniors may apply online at www.socialsecurity.gov, or contact the SHIIP office. The Senior Center can assist you with completing the on-line application process or with a paper application.
