Guest Speaker: The Honorable Judge William Souther, III

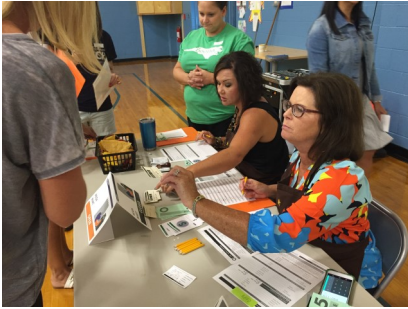
