- The PTRC completed their monitoring of the Senior Services Nutrition, Transportation, and Legal programs yesterday (12/13) and there were NO FINDINGS!!
- Today's Bank Balance is \$2,173,738.09
- Our Indirect Cost Proposal submitted in June has been approved by the Dept. of Health and Human Services. The new approved Indirect Cost Rate of 12.9% will begin 7/1/24.
- YVEDDI Resource building, fire, sanitation, and Licensing inspections were completed on 11/9/23. It took Pinnacle Moving Company 4 days to move us finishing up on 11/17/23. I'm looking forward to taking you around for a tour after the meeting.
- We have a planning committee established for the YRC Open House. Our event date is being planned for Friday, January 19 from 1 3 pm. We will have door prizes, refreshments, a live broadcast from WPAQ/WSYD, and will have a mock check presentation from Food Lion per their partnership with Meals on Wheels of America for the \$20,000 we received for the upfit of this building.
- Our final report to the Cannon Foundation was submitted on Monday (12/11). The report
  included challenges and successes with the renovations project, how the foundation's
  contributions were used for the upfit, and I uploaded some pictures to showcase the
  process.
- I am happy to report that we have 2 agencies who are in the process of contracting with us to rent 4 offices here at the YRC. Watauga Opportunities and Goodwill

This is in your Board packet on pages 39-50. Jeff said the Federal Transit Administration said we no longe have to specifically do urine testing for our drug and alcohol testing, we can do oral testing. He said this is where you can collect the salvia and send it off to the lab, but to do that the consultant firm issued a new drug testing policy and changed any references regarding urine specimen to "specimen", which will allow for oral fluid testing. Jeff said the State of NC has to approve (2) labs to send the specimens to but this has not been done by the state yet. Eddie Harris asked if we did background checks on our drivers, and Jeff said pre-hire and then twice a year. Mickey asked for any discussion and there was none.
