Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) Program

The primary long-range goal is to reduce the number of under-resourced individuals/families in our communities. This will be achieved by providing comprehensive case management services and activities to families that are enrolled in the program.

Our CSBG Program believes that those in poverty solve immediate, concrete problems every day using reactive problem-solving skills and relationships. We continue to strengthen those relationships within society with adequate resources, referrals, support networks, prioritizing obtainable goals, and capitalizing on customer strengths.

Each eligible individual/family enrolled in the program can be assisted for up to a two (2) year period, effective from the date of enrollment. A contract/agreement is developed prior to enrollment in the program. This contract contains the barriers/needs, a plan of action, and a work plan, agreed upon by the customer and the CSBG staff. The plan outlines the responsibilities of all parties involved.

Our Self-Sufficiency Program is based upon the following beliefs:

- Poverty and unstable situations can trap people in the “tyranny of the moment”
- Helping people help themselves should be a way of life
- Able-bodied people should work
- Participants will begin to understand that poverty is not always a “lack of “....

Eligibility/Enrollment

All potential participants are provided with an orientation to the full array of CSBG services. If applicants are interested in pursuing services, they participate in the Intake Process, which is an information gathering procedure. Data is collected to build a case history and to allow for a Needs Assessment of the applicants’ current situation. This information will be reviewed by a team of Success Coaches. To serve our participants more effectively we will investigate and exhaust every idea regarding what services can be mobilized within Yadkin Valley Economic Development District, Inc. (YVEDDI), and within the community.

Participants who are eligible will be enrolled into the Self-Sufficiency Program in accordance with the federal poverty guidelines as long as funding is available. The Success Coach and the participant will jointly complete a comprehensive Success Plan that determines program readiness. Realistic long-term self-sufficiency goals and practical short-term objectives will be emphasized.

If the participant does not make a responsible effort to follow Success Plan (contract) goals and objectives within ninety (90) days after signing the Success Plan, the participant will have terminated him/herself from the Program.

Self-Sufficiency

The Self-Sufficiency Program is designed to assist individuals/families to overcome poverty. Our service model assists participants to obtain the necessary resources for a full life, insights into the hidden rules of economic class, develop strategies to evaluate themselves, choose behaviors, and make plans to help stabilize their environment, and build resources for a better life. We require that all participants take the Money Smart Online course to assist them in understanding the importance of money management and financial well-being.

Our CSBG Program boosts Self-Sufficiency participants self-esteem, self-confidence, and assertiveness in taking greater control of their lives. We do this by establishing a relationship of mutual respect. We empower participants through our Self-Sufficiency Program philosophy that human services offered without integrative services and intensive success coaching are often unsuccessful. Therefore, we will continue to provide supportive services, including direct customer assistance, intensive, holistic, and individualized success coaching, and personal support to empower and help remove barriers in their lives to become self-sufficient.
