

Recent Monitoring

The YVEDDI Senior Services program was monitored by the Piedmont Triad Regional Council for program compliance in early December. The monitors reviewed Congregate Nutrition, Home Delivered Meals, Elderly Transportation, and Senior Legal Assistance, and we're thrilled to report there were **NO FINDINGS!** Congratulations to the Senior Services staff, and thank you for making YVEDDI shine!

The YVEDDI Domestic Violence program underwent monitoring in February by the NC Council for Women, and we are proud to announce full compliance with all 39 pages of regulatory requirements. Congratulations to the Domestic Violence staff, and thank you for making YVEDDI shine!

Mocksville Head Start Renovations

In December, YVEDDI acquired ownership of the former Jerricho-Hardison Community Center on Greenhill Road in Mocksville, where we will provide Head Start preschool services. Renovations are underway, and the facility is on track to open this fall to serve children in the area.

New Board Members

In February, YVEDDI welcomed new board members Commissioner Van Tucker from Surry County and Commissioner Ricky Oliver from Yadkin County. We are excited to collaborate with you both to serve our local communities!

New Vans Are Coming In

New vans are arriving at YVEDDI! In FY23, we ordered 11 new vans to replace older, high-mileage vehicles that had reached the end of their useful life. Due to supply chain delays and complications with the contract, we've just started receiving the new vans, with 8 of the 11 now in our possession. These new vans will help reduce maintenance costs and provide more comfortable rides for our passengers.
